- The number of reported **HATE CRIMES** in Ohio continues to disproportionally affect marginalized communities.
- **ANTI-SEMITISM** increased more than 34% in our country over the past year.

• The Southern Poverty Law Center's Teaching Tolerance project documents that **HATE IN SCHOOLS** is directed toward individuals or groups on the basis of their perceived race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, gender expression, gender identity, immigration status, religion, and more.

• More than one out of every five students in the United States reports being **BULLIED**.

OUR PROGRAMS HAVE


• The Diversity Center serves 11 NORTHEAST OHIO COUNTIES.

• 92% of students participating in programs from The Diversity Center showed that they had learned skills and/or strategies following the session.

• 88% of educators agree that participants were presented with age-appropriate content and activities that were ALIGNED TO SCHOOL NEEDS/GOALS.

• Over 90% of students agree they are CHALLENGED TO MAKE BETTER DECISIONS based upon program learning.

• About 88% of students agree that they are now EMPOWERED to identify diversity challenges within their surroundings and BECOME POSITIVE CHANGE AGENTS.
