Forming a Team—The Nuts and Bolts Quick Guide for the 22nd Annual Walk, Rock, Roll & Run

1. Go To: Visit the <u>RunSignUp link</u>, click on "register for 1 & 3 mile Walks and 5K Run

2. Choose Your Event: Sign up for your preferred event, a) 5K Run and Fundraise, b) 3 Mile Walk and Fundraise, c) 1 Mile Walk and Fundraise, or d) Shirt Only (the Run/Walks are not included in this option)

3. Registration: Log in if you've visited before; reset your password if needed. Enter personal information and proceed to the "registration complete" page. .

4. Team Creation or Joining: After selecting your event, scroll down to find the Group/Team prompt. Click "Yes," agree to the waiver, and proceed by clicking "Continue." On the next page, choose to join or create a team. To join, search and click your team name, then follow instructions. To create, follow the provided instructions.

5. Registering Additional Participants: While finalizing your registration, seize the chance to include other participants. Each participant added will receive a confirmation email.

6. Customize Your Fundraising Page: Every participant and Team Captain will be provided with a fundraising page. Upon completing your registration, check your confirmation email for a link to your fundraising page. Alternatively, you can access your page by following these steps:

- a. Visit the <u>RunSignUp</u> link and log in.
- b. Click on the person icon located in the upper right-hand corner.
- c. Select "Profile."

7. Unlock your "WHY" power! Edit your fundraiser to create a unique URL, set a bold fundraising goal, add a impactful photo, and share a compelling message about why Justice, Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion (JEDI) ignite your passion.




